# NIGHTSTALKER RAMPAGE ENDS IN MISSION VIEJO

The summer of 1985 was hot and terrifying for Southern California. On August 25, 1985, Richard Ramirez pulled his orange Toyota station wagon onto Via Zaragosa in Mission Viejo looking

for someone to kill. At home, in the garage working on his minibike was 13 year old James Romero. James heard footsteps on the side of his house and then saw through the little screened vent a few inches off the garage floor, a pair of feet walk by.

Petrified, James ran to his dad yelling they had a prowler in the yard. They both went to the front window and saw a

man run across their front yard and get into the orange Toyota. James and his dad went outside and as the Toyota drove slowly by, James wrote down the license plate number and called police.

James and L.A. Rams owner Georgia Frontiere: The plague said "To a Real American Hero"

An hour later, Richard Ramirez drove down Chrisanta Drive in Mission Viejo and saw a house with the garage door slightly open. He crawled inside the house, found and shot Bill Carns in the head and raped his girlfriend.

It would be the last attack from the Night Stalker. Orange County Sheriff Deputies used the license plate number provided from James and his dad and had the name and fingerprint of Richard Ramirez. He was arrested not long after that terrible night when he made the decision to come to Mission Viejo.

Thirteen year old Mission Viejo resident James Romero was a hero. He received reward money, Rams tickets, an ATV from Mission Yamaha, and he testified in an LA courtroom for two days. Today, James is 45 years old, married and with 4

his time on the witness stand, Richard Ramirez would stare at him, and one time, Ramirez locked eves with him and winked.

Tourette Syndrome Awareness Month is May 15th – June 15th. That's right folks, not even an individual calendar month. Tourette Syndrome is a tic disorder-which involves repetitive movements and vocalizations, and is usually child onset at about eight years old. Coprolalia (aka bad words) amounts for less than 10% of TS cases. Most children with TS have quirky head and eye movements; it gets especially noticeable when they are excited or nervous. Sometimes, there is no rhyme or reason....oftentimes, the movement tics hurt. It's painful and exhausting.

# LOOKING BEYOND

### Saddleback College Observatory

The Saddleback Observatory was recently completed in 2016, and is operated by the Astronomy Department under the direction of Dr. Mitch Haeri and Jason Smith. The primary telescope is a professional 16" f10 Schmidt-Cassegrain mounted on a newly finished, state-of-the-art Equatorial Mount. The telescope is

> housed in an observatory having an 18 foot dome.

The fully-automated telescope is controlled with advanced Bisque observatory software identical to the software used at some of the world's largest observatories. Two 42" 4K monitors provide remote viewing of astronomical objects

and other telescope operations. The observatory facility includes an outdoors observation deck with twenty powered piers for the school's numerous 8" Schmidt-Cassigrains.

While the observatory grounds are generally limited to student and faculty use, they are open to the public after regularly scheduled Saddleback College Astronomy and Physics Club meeting, as well

as for special astronomical events as announced.





Camouflaged in the hills throughout Mission Viejo are several water tanks. Santa Margarita Water District has three of them and all are on constant security surveillance watch. - Alicia (located on Alicia Pkwy between Santa Margarita Parkway & Olympiad), Casta del Sol (located in the CDS development), and O'Neill (located on Felipe just south of La Paz.)




The tanks are located on selected hills due to the need for efficiency and the cost of moving water both into and out of the reservoirs. Part of the beauty of Mission Viejo is it's topography,

but it takes a lot of energy to move the water around, up and down, those grades

The system is designed to pump water into the reservoir at night when energy is cheaper, and then gravity takes care of moving water during the day.
