Moral courage is being brave enough to stand up for what is right, although it may not be popular or easy, and even if you stand alone. There is often a risk and a cost associated with moral courage. It is important to note that there are different forms of courage. Most often when we think of courage, we think of acts of bravery, which could hurt the body—such as running into a burning building or onto a battlefield in war. That physical type of courage is important but is not often required in most of our lives. Moral courage is different from physical courage, and our moral courage is tested every day. Living according to moral principles usually requires us to take a risk and there may be a cost to us—monetary costs, ridicule, or damage to relationships or a career. Moral courage is to do the right thing, and by displaying this trait you may be influencing others to make good decisions as well. As Billy Graham said, "Courage is contagious. When a brave man takes a stand, the spines of others are often stiffened."

All 25 of our Mission Viejo schools receive the City's character program. Research has proven character education to be a positive force in reducing disruptive behavior, alcohol and drug abuse, and teen pregnancy. It contributes to safe and orderly schools, reduced discipline problems, greater academic achievement, and higher student and staff morale. 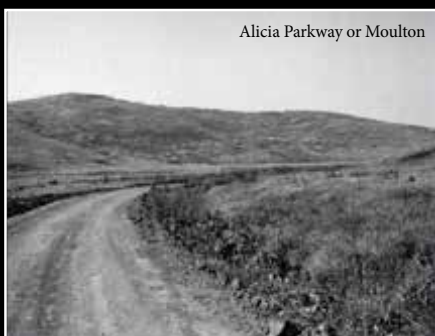

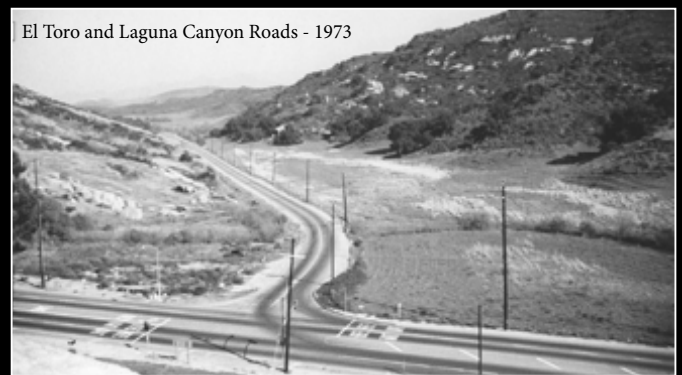


View from El Toro Rd. looking down the future Rockfield

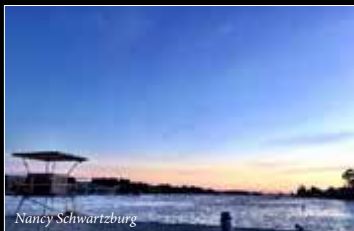
