

When a brave man takes a stand, the spines of others are often stiffened."

Research has proven character education to be a positive force in reducing disruptive behavior, alcohol and drug abuse, and teen pregnancy. It contributes to safe and orderly schools, reduced discipline problems, greater academic achievement, and higher student and staff morale.
